June 27 - July 1 "School's Out!" Week - What a fun way to jump into summer break! Designed for our beginner and intermediate CSF riders. All ages and abilities are welcome. We'll have fun activities and different challenges for the more advanced riders, too.

July 11 - 15 Combined Training - Fun and intensive session of flat work with focus on equitation and riding precision patterns. For our jumpers, daily work on effective riding over a course. Participants in this session will have the opportunity to ride a combined test for a guest judge on Thurs. This is a great opportunity for our student riders!

July 25 - 29 Horse Show Prep - A hit in previous years, this week will focus on all aspects of preparation and participation in horse shows. Show grooming, schooling and ring etiquette for flat and over-fence classes will be covered. Riders will have the opportunity to participate in a show at the end of the week. We welcome all riding levels for this week.

August 15 - 19 Combined Training - Fun and intensive session of flat work with focus on equitation and execution of precision patterns. With hopes of working with riders who participated in the first Combined session, an advanced approach will allow riders to ride several horses through each revolution.
