

CLASS DIVISIONS

Leadline Class 1

Open to children under 7 as of December 1, who have not competed other than in Lead Line classes. Must be lead by an adult. Will be asked to trot or jog.

Walk-Trot Hunt Seat Equitation Classes 2,3,4

Open to riders 10 years and under who have not competed in any class requiring them to canter or jump. Riders may not compete in Short Stirrup classes. Riders will be asked to walk and trot in both directions of the ring. They will be judged on position and ability to control their mounts. Diagonals will be considered.

Short Stirrup Equitation Classes 5,6,7,8

Open to riders 12 and under who have never who have never competed over fences exceeding 18". Riders in this division may not compete in any other classes exceeding 18" with the exception of pleasure and pet type pony classes. Shown at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Diagonals and leads considered. Fences not to exceed 18".

Long Stirrup Equitation Classes 9, 10, 11, 12

Open to riders 18 years and older in first years of showing. Riders not eligible for any other classes except Pleasure. Fences not to exceed 18".

Adult Equitation Division Classes 13, 14, 15

Open to riders 18 years and older. Riders may not compete in Long Stirrup. Fences not to exceed 2'.

Childrens' Equitation Division Classes 16, 17, 18

Open to riders under 18 who have not competed in fences over 2'6". Riders may not compete in Short Stirrup. Fences not to exceed 2'.

Junior Open Pleasure Classes 19, 20, 21

Open to riders under 18. To be judged on horse's performance at the walk, trot/jog & canter/lope.

Adult Open Pleasure Classes 22, 23, 24

Open to riders 18 and older. To be judged on horse's performance at the walk, trot/jog & canter/lope

Schooling Hunter Classes 25, 26, 27

Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Fences 2'. No combinations.

Combined Training Show

Riders will compete in show jumping and a dressage test.
